Champe F Markham to Sally H Cocke; 23 Dec 1818; security - John Cocke; minister - Reuben Ford; application for license dated 21 Dec 1818.

1822; Champ F Markham to John Guarrant, Robert Simpson and . . . trustees for William Taurman and Guerrant and Watkins . . . trust conveying real and personal estate was on the first day of Mar 1822 presented to me in my office and acknowledged by Champ F Markham to be his act and deed and submitted to record.

1822, 1 Mar; Indenture between Champe F Markham of Goochland and Guerrant, Sampson and Perkins. Champe Markham is contracting to pay his debts within 12 months or assign his right to his father's estate over to Guerrant, Sampson and Perkins to satisfy his debts.

1822, Apr 1822; Champ F Markham appeared in court . . . to the condition of his . . . for a breach of the peace . . . witnesses being sworn and examined for reasons appearing to the court . . . said Markham is discharged.

1829, 11 Nov; Indenture between Champe F Markham and William Anderson and John Martin. Champe assigns red cow, spotted sow, seven pigs, 1 tea kettle and two grubbing hoes in payment of his debt. [source] Deeds of Goochland County Virginia; Book 28, page 324.

1830, Feb 1830; Champ F Markham to William M Anderson and John Martin trustees for the benefit of Thomas Cocke. Deed acknowledged by Champe F Markham and ordered to be recorded.

1831, Mar 1831; Champ F Markham to John Pollock trustee for the benefit of Watkins . . . deed of trust conveying personal estate was on 15 Mar 1831 acknowledged by Champe F Markham and admitted to record.

1830 Census of Goochland County Virginia - living next to his mother
Champe Markham; 2 m 0-5; 1m 5-10; 1m 10-15; 1m 30-40; 1f 0-5*; 1f 30-40; 5 slaves
*note – another recording of this census shows this female as age 5-10

1831, 15 Mar; Champe F Markham of Goochland selling 2 beds, 6 chairs, one trunk, one cupboard, one table, one large iron pot, one dutch oven, one tea kettle, one skillet, four pitchers, six dishes, 18 plates, 6 cups and saucers, 2 coffee pots, six knives and forks, 1 water, etc . . . and his crop of wheat which he is growing to pay his debt.

1840 Census of Warren county Mississippi
Champe Markham; 2m 10-15; 1m 15-20; 2m 40-50; 1f 0-5; 1f 5-10; 1f 30-40

1845 Mississippi State census lists these Markhams in Warren county Mississippi – Edward Markham, George Markham, HM (Hugh) Markham, WF (William Fleming) Markham.

1851, 7 January; [notes from a deed] Champe F Markham and Charles Guerrant. Indicates that when John Markham's land was sold to Charles Guerrant, Champe F Markham withheld his portion which was 1/11th of property amounting to 505 1/2 acres. (Champe Markham died 1846-1849) It mentions a case presently pending in favor of John S Fleming against Champe F Markham and names his administrator as Charles Guerrant. Exactly what this deed settles is difficult to interpret. Apparently John Markham's land, identified as on Beaverdam Creek, adjoining John Martin in Goochland county Virginia is being sold to Narcissus W Miller by Charles Guerrant.

In reference to the original case, still pending, which was probably first brought forth in 1835, it names George W Markham, son of John Markham deceased as plaintiff and Lucy C Markham widow of said John Markham deceased and Bernard M Markham, Champe F Markham, William F Markham and Susan P his wife, Mary E Markham and Linnaeus B Markham and Elizabeth his wife, Hugh M Markham, Martha B Markham, Aubin M Markham and John N Markham, Putnam T Williams and John Samuel and Mary B Williams were defendants.
