1818; George Markham and Frances his wife of the county of Powhatan (first) and William Bodnan Harwood of Petersburg (second) and Littleberry Steinbeck, Richard Drummond and Spence Drummond, Petersburg merchants (third). Whereas George Markham has entered into a partnership with Cralle Finney, under the firm of Markham and Finney and arrangements have been made between the said firm Markham and Finney and the said firm of LE Steinbeck, by which it is supposed that the latter will be creditors of the former...George Markham must establish security, mortgages his 504 acres on Fighting Creek.

George Markham; 3m0-10; 1m 10-16; 1m 28-45; 1f 0-10; 2f 10-16; 1f 26-45; 16 slaves, primarily engaged in agriculture

1822; George Markham of Powhatan (first), Jones and Moseley (second) and Moseley (third), George Markham stands in debt for \$1,600 as executor of Bernard Markham as pronounced in a suit in the Richmond Court of Chauncery--Higgenbotham vs Bernard Markham. George is securing this debt by mortgage.

Signed by JB Green, Henry Didlake, and Pleasant Labby, Lynchburg Justices of Peace.
